What are we looking for?

The opportunity is open to **UK based UKNA/UKYA Alumni** who consider themselves at a turning point in their career. UKNA and 4C Group recognises the difficulties faced by those who would struggle to further their career without support. You may feel that you have faced difficulties due to social, cultural, economic or access conditions. We will be assessing using the following criteria:

- How well you outline how this opportunity is crucial to your artistic and professional development
- How being awarded a bursary and being part of the New Artist Collective will impact change for you
- You have demonstrated promise in your discipline
- You possess a strong voice, skill and ambition in your practice

Eligibility

- Artists must be within the first 10 years of their professional practice
- Artists from all artforms can apply
- You must be eligible to live, study or work in the UK and be doing so at the time of making this application
- Individuals, collaborators and or collectives can apply
- You are a UK based **UKNA/UKYA Alumni** (*we consider this to be those who have been selected for any UK New Artists or UK Young Artists programme from 2014 to present*)

Your proposal for support

Your proposal is a key part of the application and we **are asking for no more than 300 words which should focus on the bursary and New Artist Collective**, clearly demonstrating why the opportunity is crucial to your professional & artistic development as well as outline the inhibitors to moving forward with your work. It is open to you how you define this and some examples are as follows:

- Time to create
- Paying for your studio for six months or block buying rehearsal space, etc.
- Developing new skills
- Buying tools or materials to make your work
- Match funding for a bigger project
- Travel for research and development

(Please note the bursary cannot be used towards personal living costs)

All applications will be reviewed by a selection panel, composed of UKNA, members of our Creative Think Tank, sector specialists and 4C Group staff who will be announced in due course. Please assume your application has been unsuccessful if you have not heard by **Tuesday 25th April**.

We are open to receiving applications in a variety of ways in order to make this process accessible to everyone. If you would like to apply via video or audio, please ensure that the file is in MP3/MP4 format and no longer than 5 minutes. If you would like an informal chat with a staff
